Job Purpose:

To provide impartial advice, information and support to parents/carers of children who are finding it difficult to access education in Northumberland.

Duties and key result areas:

- 1. Help parents and carers who have difficulty with accessing appropriate education, or who are excluded form education to make informed decisions about the education provision that's best for their children, by explaining the options that are available and helping them to navigate the process.
- 2. Work with school leaders and staff, the LA Admissions team, LA support teams e.g. Inclusion and other local support groups to ensure parents and carers receive the relevant information and support they need to make the best decisions possible for their child's education.
- 3. To support parents of children with Education Helath Care Plans (EHCP's) with mainstream school options when moving thorugh the phases of education.
- 4. Through partnership working with other professionals help to secure the statutory entitlement to education for all children in a timely manner.
- 5. Support the Admissions Team by carrying out desk based research to locate families who fail to submit application paperwork for a school place, and then help such families to comply with the application process.
- 6. Support with emergency and new arrival applications from Ukraine and other overseas applicants who are seeking refuge or asylumin including liaison with other relevant agencies/organisations e.g Home Office.
- 7. Represent parents at reviews / panels / governor hearings / appeals when appropriate, and advocate for them in an independent capacity when required.
- 8. To contribute to the development of documents, policies and guidance papers relating to access to education, for example the Fair Access Protocol.
- 9. Maintain detailed and up to date case notes and communication logs for all families, schools and children supported.
- 10. Provide feedback to parents following key meetings concerning their child, for example Inclusion Panel, Fair Access meetings or governor hearings.
- 11. Ensure Children's Social Care are informed of any children who are struggling to access education who may be at a safeguarding risk.
