Work Arrangements	
Physical requirements:	Predominantly standing or climbing using rope & harness access and MEWPS, with frequent walking, frequent ongoing lifting and carrying heavy items, pulling, and pushing, often on uneven ground and difficult terrain. Need to remain alert for traffic and other potential hazards. Capable of complying with the physical demands of the posts and with special awareness when working with chainsaws and specialist equipment.
Transport requirements:	Need to attend training and development/refresher courses, meetings or other work sites as required.
Working patterns:	Normal working week, Monday to Friday, with occasional evening, weekend and emergency call out work. Driving regulations apply, where applicable.
Working conditions:	Extensive exposure to working outdoors in all weathers and traffic, with exposure to specific hazardous situations for which the wearing and use of specialist protective clothing and equipment will be required. Due to geographical area this can lead to working in remote locations.
