Blyth Riverside Resource Centre offers service users the opportunity to take part in a range of group activities including gardening, music, cooking, arts and crafts, games and sensory activities, as well as day trips, centre-based discos, "Wacky" sport days, pantomimes, bowling and Christmas Fairs.

Blyth Riverside also has a multi-sensory room and an offsite accessible allotment.

Service users organise events and are involved in an annual football competition at the local leisure centre.

The service can provide shared transport for service users who are unable to travel independently and has three wheelchair accessible vehicles.
